







FY 2018 Cumulative Financial Results




FirstNet's FY 2019 Budget Formulation Timeline

NPSBN Program Status

FirstNet Core

- Completed validation of all 288 Requirements Traceability Matrix (RTM) items for Task Order 3 IOC-2, and full service now available on FirstNet Core
- Preliminary Design Review (PDR) for Task Order 3 IOC-3 completed May 30-31 in Oakton, VA

Devices and Applications

- Initial NIST list published with 17 approved devices to date, with evaluation of new devices continuing

RAN Deployment and Operations

- Initial RAN operations review held May 31 in Oakton, VA
- FirstNet assessing/qualifying Task Order 4 RTM and deliverables for TO4 IOC-1 and IOC-2, which will run in parallel

Firstnet Innovation and Test Lab

- AT&T completed the installation and testing of vendor eNB equipment in the FirstNet Innovation and Test Lab

State Plan Content

- Task Order 1 period of performance expected to continue through March 2020
- Task Order 2 period of performance ended and closed out


Highlights

- 60,000+ customers at 650+ agencies onboarded to FirstNet service since launch
- Service launched on FirstNet Core, including for self-pay and volunteer public safety
- Device offerings include Band-14-capable smartphones and Band 14-capable mobile hotspot
- Awarded Task Order 4 in March; includes build, deployment, and maintenance of state RANs

- Critical Design Review (CDR) scheduled for week of September 9 at Boulder office
